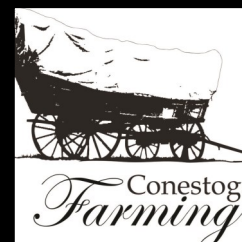

The Conestoga Simmentaler herd is based at Thornham Farm in the Kokstad area of East Griqualand and is a very hard red-water area. Both the bulls have been used in the stud and have grown up working and fed mainly on grass and licks. The Conestoga type of cattle are bred to be earlier maturing, easier keeping cattle that have to survive and produce on natural resources. 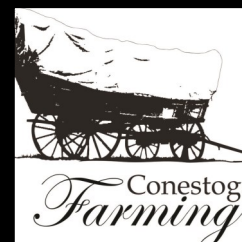
